The Pope invited Bishops and priests from around the world - on March 25, 2022 - to join him in consecrating "all humanity, especially Russia and Ukraine" to The Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady of Fatima requested specifically that Russia be singularly and specifically consecrated by name. The question is whether or not Our Lady of Fatima's Request has been fulfilled or not. I personally think that the consecration has not been done properly and the failure to do the Consecration as Our Lady asked for - will have serious repercussions on the whole world and the Church.

What Our Lady of Fatima asked for, is the Pope to Consecrate Russia - ALONE - to the Immaculate Heart of Mary - in union with all the Bishops of the world at the same time. Those Bishops could even pray the consecration in their own Cathedrals. What makes the Consecration Valid and Pleasing to God, is that only the nation of Russia be SINGULARLY and SPECIFICALLY mentioned BY NAME.

The word consecrate means to set aside for a holy purpose. Our Lady did not ask the Pope to consecrate and set aside "all humanity, especially Russia and Ukraine", but to SINGULARLY and SPECIFICALLY CONSECRATE AND SET ASIDE THE NATION OF RUSSIA to THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY.

One might ask "Why does it need to be that way?" - I think it is for the reason that Our Lady warned us that Specifically, Russia would spread her errors throughout the world.

Our Lady then said to me[Lucia]:

"The moment has come in which God asks the Holy Father, in union with all the Bishops of the world, to make the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means. There are so many souls whom the justice of God condemns for sins committed against me[Our Lady, the Blessed Virgin Mary], that I have come to ask reparation: sacrifice yourself for this intention and pray."

I gave an account of this to the confessor, who ordered me to write down what Our Lady wanted done.

Later, in an intimate communication, Our Lord complained to me, saying:

"They did not wish to heed my request. Like the King of France, they will repent and do it, but it will be late, Russia will have already spread her errors throughout the world, provoking wars, and persecutions of the Church; the Holy Father will have much to suffer."

<u>I firmly believe that if the Pope were to pray a prayer similar to the following prayer</u> in union with all the Bishops of the world at the same time - even if the Bishops said the prayer in their own Cathedrals or their own location, again, at the same time, then God would grant through Mother Mary a period of peace to the world and the Church.

- A form of governing "revolutionary socialism" that is also constitutionally called "Democratic Centralism," the latter formulation meaning that things have the appearance of being openly democratic, yet they are all centrally organized and managed in the background (Dr. Robert Hickson recently applied this principle to the current situation in the Church "especially with regard to the Family Synods" here);
- A disregard for tradition and for the traditional institutions of society (or now of the Church, such as the Curia?) as "counter-revolutionary forces";
 - A deceitful misuse of language with the intent to manipulate the public;
- A method of branding one's own opponents with sweeping and demeaning epithets that abstractly categorize them as "right-wing" or "counter-revolutionary" [and what about the most-common term in use among the left: "fascist"?];

- An approach to ongoing revolutionary changes where there is both "a slow path" and "a fast path" of the Revolution; such is "the Dialectic" and the "dialectical process";
- Toward more moderate and compromising opponents, one first tries to incorporate them into the professed new system so as to use them as Lenin's "useful idiots" in the sense that they help give to the world the illusory idea that nothing has really changed;
- As a last element "but of course a very important and painful one for those who lived under Communism" there is a constant sense of distrust and fear, unto the imprisonment and killing of one's intransigent opponents."
